Maple syrup urine disease The condition gets its name from the distinctive sweet odor of affected infants' urine and earwax due to the buildup of these amino acids. Atipamezole There is a low rate of side effects, largely due to atipamezole's high specificity for the $\alpha 2$ -adrenergic receptor. It is mainly used in veterinary medicine, and while it is only licensed for dogs and for intramuscular use, it has been used intravenously, as well as in cats and other animals (intravenous use in cats and dogs is not recommended due to the potential for cardiovascular collapse. Its reversal effect works by

competing with the sedative for α_2 -adrenergic receptors and displacing them. This occurs due to profound hypotension caused by reversal of the alpha 1 effects while the reflex bradycardia is still in effect.). overdose include panting, trembling, vomiting, and diarrhea, as well as increased blood levels of creatine kinase, aspartate transaminase, and alanine transaminase Atipamezole, sold under the brand name Antisedan among others, is a synthetic α_2 adrenergic receptor antagonist used for the reversal of the sedative and analgesic effects of dexmedetomidine and medetomidine in dogs. Atipamezole has a very quick onset, usually waking an animal up within 5 to 10 minutes

Hyperthyroidism is an endocrine disease in which the thyroid gland produces excessive amounts of thyroid hormones. Symptoms are typically less severe in the elderly and during pregnancy. An uncommon but life-threatening complication is thyroid storm in which an event such as an infection results in worsening symptoms such as confusion and a high temperature; this often results in death. Thyrotoxicosis is a condition that occurs due to elevated levels of thyroid hormones of any cause and therefore includes hyperthyroidism 1fb7ba35d3

Classic galactosemia is a rare (1 in 47,000 live births), autosomal recessive disease that presents with symptoms soon after birth when a baby begins lactose ingestion. Symptoms include life-threatening illnesses such as jaundice, hepatosplenomegaly (enlarged spleen and liver), hypoglycemia, renal tubular dysfunction, muscle hypotonia (decreased tone and muscle strength), sepsis (presence of harmful bacteria and their toxins in tissues), and cataract among others. The prevalence of cataract among classic galactosemics is markedly less than among galactokinase-deficient patients due to the extremely high levels of galactitol found in the latter. Classic...

Maple syrup urine disease can be classified by its pattern of signs and symptoms or by its genetic cause. The most common and severe form of this disease is the classic type, which appears soon after birth, and as long as it remains untreated, gives rise to progressive and unremitting symptoms. Variant forms of the disorder may become apparent only later in infancy or childhood, with typically less severe symptoms that may only appear during times of fasting, stress, or illness, but still involve mental and physical problems if left untreated.

TSS is typically caused by bacteria of the *Streptococcus pyogenes* or *Staphylococcus aureus* type, though others may also be involved. Streptococcal toxic shock syndrome is sometimes referred to as toxic-shock-like syndrome (TSLS). The underlying mechanism involves the production of superantigens during an invasive streptococcus

infection or a localized staphylococcus infection. Risk factors for the staphylococcal type include the use of very absorbent tampons, skin lesions in young children characterized by fever, low blood pressure, rash, vomiting and/or diarrhea, and multiorgan failure. Diagnosis is typically based on symptoms.

Many substances, such as anabolic steroids, can be used to improve athletic performance and build muscle, which in most cases is considered cheating by organized athletic organizations. This usage is often referred to as doping. Athletic performance-enhancing substances are sometimes referred to as ergogenic aids. Cognitive performance-enhancing drugs, commonly called nootropics, are sometimes used by students to improve academic performance. Chylomicron retention disease Mutations in SAR1B prevent the release of chylomicrons in the circulation which leads to nutritional and developmental problems. Since the disease allele is recessive, parents usually do not show symptoms. with the disease. It is a rare autosomal recessive disorder with around 40 cases reported worldwide. It is associated with SAR1B. Careful regulation Chylomicron retention disease is a disorder of fat absorption. Creatine was first identified in 1832 when Michel Eugène Chevreul isolated the precipitate from the basified water-extract of skeletal muscle. He later named the crystallized precipitate after the Greek word for meat, κρέας (kreas). In 1928, creatine was shown to exist in equilibrium with creatinine. Studies in the 1920s showed that consumption of large amounts of creatine did not result in its excretion. This result pointed to the ability of the body to store creatine, which in turn suggested its use as a dietary supplement. 1fb7ba35d3 The presence of presenile cataract, noticeable in galactosemic infants as young as a few days old, is

highly associated with two distinct types of galactosemia: GALT deficiency and to a greater extent, GALK deficiency. 1fb7ba35d3 == Types == 1fb7ba35d3 While some VHFs are generally mild, such as nephropathia epidemica (caused by two species of hantavirus), many are debilitating or lethal without treatment. Outbreaks of VHFs tend to have high case fatality rates and disproportionately affect communities with poor health infrastructure. Therefore, the emergence of VHFs is a growing public health concern. VHFs are often zoonoses, meaning they can be transmitted from wild animals to human populations; for instance, the Lassa arenavirus is spread by mice. Viral hemorrhagic fevers are caused by members of seven families of single-stranded RNA viruses: Arenaviridae, Filoviridae, Flaviviridae, Nairoviridae, Phenuiviridae, Hantaviridae and Peribunyaviridae. 1fb7ba35d3 It was originally released in 1996.
