Liver In humans, it is located in the right upper quadrant of the abdomen, below the diaphragm and mostly shielded by the lower right rib cage. attaches the gallbladder and the porta hepatis. The fossa of gallbladder lies to the right of the quadrate lobe, occupied by the gallbladder with its cystic The liver is a major metabolic organ exclusively found in vertebrates which performs many essential biological functions, such as detoxification of the organism and the synthesis of various proteins and various other biochemicals necessary for digestion and growth. Anatomical and medical terminology often use the prefix hepat- from ἥπατο-, from the Greek word for liver, such as hepatology, and hepatitis. Other causes include alcohol, smoking, cocaine, severe illness, autoimmune problems, radiation therapy and Crohn's disease. Endoscopy, a type of X-ray known as an upper gastrointestinal series, blood tests, and stool tests may help with diagnosis. Laparoscopic surgery, also called minimally invasive procedure, bandaid surgery, or keyhole surgery, is a modern surgical technique. There are a number of advantages to the patient with laparoscopic surgery versus an exploratory laparotomy. These include reduced pain due to smaller incisions, reduced hemorrhaging, and shorter recovery time. The key element is the use of a laparoscope, a long fiber optic cable system that allows viewing of the affected area by snaking the cable from a more distant, but more easily accessible location. 9268a70cbb The two most common causes of acute pancreatitis are a gallstone blocking the common bile duct after the pancreatic duct has joined; and heavy alcohol use. Pancreatitis The pancreas is a large organ behind the stomach that produces digestive enzymes and a number of hormones. (ERCP) may be done to examine the distal common bile duct and remove a gallstone if present. The pain often goes into the back and is usually severe. Signs and symptoms of pancreatitis include pain in the upper abdomen, nausea, and vomiting. In chronic pancreatitis, weight loss, fatty stool, and diarrhea may occur. Complications may include infection, bleeding, diabetes mellitus, or problems with other organs. There are two main types, acute pancreatitis and chronic pancreatitis. In those with gallstones the gallbladder is often also removed Pancreatitis is a condition characterized by inflammation of the pancreas. In acute pancreatitis, a fever may occur; symptoms typically resolve in a few days 9268a70cbb

The digestive system functions to move material through the GI tract via peristalsis, break down that material via digestion, absorb nutrients for use throughout the body, and remove waste from the body via defecation. dietary fructose intolerance (DFI), is a digestive disorder in which absorption of fructose is impaired by deficient fructose carriers in the small intestine's enterocytes

People are, however, usually advised to avoid foods that trigger Gastritis is the inflammation of the lining of the stomach. specific foods, including spicy foods and coffee, in the development of peptic ulcers. Other symptoms include nausea and vomiting, bloating, indigestion, loss of appetite and heartburn. Complications may include stomach bleeding, stomach ulcers, and stomach tumors. There may be no symptoms, but the most common symptom is upper abdominal pain. Autoimmune atrophic gastritis may lead to issues including pernicious anemia 9268a70cbb
