Androctonus bicolor Jacobs, Daniel; *Androctonus bicolor*, the black fat-tailed scorpion, is a scorpion species of the family Buthidae. Adults can reach up to 40-60 millimeters, 80 millimeters being the maximum. These scorpions enjoy making scrapes with wood and rocks, and are nocturnal, thus they hide in crevices or certain objects during the day. It is black in color and can grow up to 8 cm. They can be identified by their hefty physique. They stay in shade to retain moisture (that they obtain from prey) in their bodies, as they are susceptible to losing moisture due to their environmental preference. Black fat-tailed scorpions come from the family Buthidae, which is the largest of the scorpion family. Black fat-tailed scorpions can live for up to 5 years. antivenom that heals stings of specific species) called Anti-scorpionique is available to treat stings from a black fat-tailed scorpion.

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These scorpions typically possess black and brown coloration. They tend to move very fast, and are of an aggressive nature

Of all extant ant species, about 71% are considered to be stinging species. Notable examples include a few species of medical importance, such as *Solenopsis* (fire ants), *Pachycondyla*, *Myrmecia* (bulldog ants), and *Paraponera* (bullet ants). In the case of fire ants, the venom consists mainly of alkaloid (>95%) and protein (<1%) components. Stinging ants cause a cutaneous condition that is different from that caused by biting venomous ants. Particularly painful are stings from fire ants, although the bullet ant's sting is considered by some to be the most painful insect sting. Some subfamilies have evolutionarily lost the ability to sting.

They mainly live in deserts but have adapted to a wide range of environmental conditions, and can be found on all continents except Antarctica. There are over 2,500 described species, with 22 extant (living) families recognized to date

Androctonus crassicauda is a generalist desert species, an Old World scorpion. Adults can vary in colour from a light brown to reddish to blackish-brown, to black. They can grow to over 10 centimetres (3.9 in) in length. The painful and potentially deadly venom of Arizona bark scorpions has little effect on grasshopper mice. Scientists have found the scorpion toxin acts as an analgesic rather than a pain stimulant in grasshopper mice. Scorpions primarily prey on insects and other invertebrates, but some

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species hunt vertebrates. They use their pincers to restrain and kill prey, or to prevent their own predation. The scorpion's sting is venomous and used for offense and defense. During courtship, the male and female grasp each other's pincers and dance while the male tries to move the female onto his sperm packet. All known species give live birth and the female cares for the young as their exoskeletons harden, transporting them on her back. The exoskeleton contains fluorescent...
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
