It is the 21st most populated country in the world and has a population density of 285 people per square kilometre (740 people/mi2), with England having significantly greater density than Wales, Scotland, and Northern Ireland. In fulfilment of its former EU treaty obligations, European Union directives had been transposed into the UK legal system on an ongoing basis by the UK parliament. Upon Brexit, non-transposed EU law (such as regulations) was transplanted into domestic law as "retained EU law", with an additional period of alignment with EU law during the transition period from 31 January to 31 December 2020. 4daa66c793 Although the United Kingdom is a unitary sovereign state, it contains three distinct legal jurisdictions: England and Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland, each retaining its own legal system. Since 1998, Northern Ireland, Scotland and Wales have also gained significant autonomy through the process of devolution. The UK Parliament and UK Government deal with all reserved matters for Northern Ireland, Scotland and Wales, but not in general matters that have been devolved to the Northern Ireland Assembly, Scottish Parliament and Senedd.
