The major function of this system is as a barrier against the external environment. Within the latter type, the hairs occur in structures called pilosebaceous units, each with hair follicle, sebaceous gland, and associated arrector pili muscle. The two main types of human skin are: glabrous skin, the hairless skin on the palms and soles (also referred to as the "palmoplantar" surfaces), and hair-bearing skin. The skin weighs an average of four kilograms, covers an area of two square metres, and is made of three distinct layers: the epidermis, dermis, and subcutaneous tissue eb713f3f0a

Lichen planus There is no cure, but many medications and procedures have been used in efforts to control the symptoms. of the nail plate, pterygium formation, shedding of the nail plate with atrophy of the nail bed, subungual keratosis, longitudinal erthronychia (red streaks) Lichen planus (LP) is a chronic inflammatory and immune mediated disease that affects the skin, nails, hair, and mucous membranes. It is characterized by polygonal, flat-topped, violaceous papules and plaques with overlying, reticulated, fine white scale (Wickham's striae), commonly affecting dorsal hands, flexural wrists and forearms, trunk, anterior lower legs, and oral mucosa. Although there is a broad clinical range of LP manifestations, the

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skin and oral cavity remain the major sites of involvement. The hue may be gray-brown in people with darker skin. The cause is unknown, but it is thought to be the result of an autoimmune process with an unknown initial trigger. It is not an actual lichen, but is named for its appearance

PsA is classified as a type of seronegative spondyloarthropathy, and is a clinical diagnosis. There are no reliable tests for PsA.

PsA also often presents with nail lesions, which may include small depressions in the nail (pitting), thickening of the nails, and detachment of the nail from the nailbed. The classic features of psoriatic arthritis include enthesitis (inflammation of the entheses), synovitis (inflammation of the joint membrane), and dactylitis (sausage-like swelling of the fingers). PsA affects people with the autoimmune disease psoriasis in particular, and about 20-30% of patients with psoriasis develop PsA. Nail (anatomy) The nail matrix is the active A nail is a protective plate characteristically found at the tip of the digits (fingers and toes) of almost all primates (except for marmosets), homologous to the claws in other tetrapod animals. Fingernails and toenails are made of a tough rigid protein called alpha-keratin, a polymer also found in the claws, hooves, and horns of vertebrates. The nail consists of the nail plate, the nail matrix and the nail bed below it, and the grooves surrounding it

Plaque psoriasis, also known as psoriasis vulgaris, makes up about 90% of cases. It typically presents as red patches with white scales on top. Areas of the body most commonly affected are the back of the forearms, shins, navel area and scalp. Guttate psoriasis has drop-shaped lesions. Pustular psoriasis presents as small, noninfectious, pus-filled blisters. Inverse psoriasis forms red patches in skin folds. Erythrodermic psoriasis occurs when the rash becomes very widespread and can develop from any of the other types. Nourishment is provided to these layers by diffusion from the dermis... eb713f3f0a Melanoma is a group of serious skin cancers that arise from pigment cells (melanocytes); acral lentiginous melanoma is a kind of lentiginous skin melanoma. ALM makes up less than 5% of all melanomas, but is considered the most common subtype in people with darker skin and is rare in people with lighter skin types. It is not caused by exposure to sunlight or UV radiation, and wearing sunscreen does not protect against it. It occurs on non-hair-bearing surfaces of the body, which have not necessarily been exposed to sunlight. It is also found on mucous membranes. eb713f3f0a Genetics are thought to be strongly involved in the development of psoriatic arthritis. Acral lentiginous melanoma It may become bumpy and ulcerate. ALM is most frequently seen on the foot of a person with darker skin but can also be found in non-sun exposed areas such as the palms, soles, and under finger and toenails. As it grows, ALM may also spread to other areas of the body. When under the nail it typically appears as dark longitudinal streaks. If the melanoma involves the nail fold or the nail bed, complete excision of the nail unit might be required for accurate sampling.
