Gout Pain typically comes on rapidly, reaching maximal intensity in less than 12 hours. Potential side effects include kidney stones, anemia Gout (GOWT), also called rheumatic gout, is a form of inflammatory arthritis characterized by recurrent attacks of pain in a red, tender, hot, and swollen joint, caused by the deposition of needle-shaped crystals of the monosodium salt of uric acid. They can be generally classified into two groups by their purpose: drugs used for induction therapy (a therapy used to induce remission during the acute attack of a disease) and that for maintenance therapy c0957835b0

Common side effects include bone marrow suppression, liver toxicity, vomiting, and loss of appetite. Other serious side effects include an increased risk of future cancer and pancreatitis. Those with a genetic deficiency in thiopurine S-methyltransferase are at higher risk of side effects. Use in pregnancy may harm the baby. A generic version was approved in 2019. c0957835b0 is in the thiopurine and antimetabolite family of medications. c0957835b0 It was patented in 1979 and approved for medical use in 1987. c0957835b0 It is used to treat acute lymphocytic leukemia, Crohn's disease, and ulcerative colitis. c0957835b0 It received FDA approval on 22 December 2015. The European Commission granted a marketing authorisation valid throughout the European Union on 18 February 2016. In February 2019, lesinurad was discontinued in the United States by its manufacturer for business reasons, and was subsequently withdrawn in Europe in July 2020. c0957835b0 Treatment with nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory... c0957835b0 Lesinurad is used in combination with a xanthine oxidase inhibitor, such as allopurinol or febuxostat, for treating hyperuricemia (high levels of uric acid in the blood serum) associated with gout. It is approved only for patients who have not achieved target uric acid levels with a xanthine oxidase inhibitor alone. c0957835b0

Mercaptopurine Allopurinol inhibits xanthine oxidase, the enzyme that breaks down mercaptopurine. Specifically it is used to treat acute lymphocytic leukemia (ALL), acute promyelocytic leukemia (APL), Crohn's disease, and ulcerative colitis. other cytotoxic drugs. It is taken orally. For acute lymphocytic leukemia it is generally used with methotrexate. Those taking allopurinol (often used to prevent Mercaptopurine (6-MP), sold under the brand name Purinethol among others, is a medication used for cancer and autoimmune diseases c0957835b0

It is particularly effective in "underexcretors" (patients with fractional excretion of urate <5.5% and uric acid excretion ≤ 600 mg/day/1.73... c0957835b0 Common side effects when used orally include itchiness and rash. Common side effects when used by injection include vomiting and kidney problems. While not recommended historically, starting allopurinol during an attack of gout appears to be safe. In those already on the medication, it should be continued even during an acute gout attack. While use during pregnancy does not appear to result in harm, this use has not been well studied. Allopurinol is in the xanthine oxidase inhibitor family of medications. c0957835b0 Benzbromarone was withdrawn from most European countries in 2003 due to the risk of idiosyncratic hepatotoxicity, but remains heavily used in Asia and South America. Despite this risk, it is generally considered highly effective and well tolerated in most patients. Clinical trials dating back to 1981 and as recent as 2022, along with multiple meta-analyses, have reported its superior efficacy compared to both non-uricosuric xanthine oxidase inhibitors (allopurinol and febuxostat) as well as another uricosuric drug, probenecid. c0957835b0 Febuxostat is used to treat chronic gout and hyperuricemia. Febuxostat is typically recommended only for people who cannot tolerate allopurinol. National Institute for Health and Clinical Excellence concluded that febuxostat is more effective than standard doses of allopurinol, but not more effective than higher doses of allopurinol. c0957835b0 Mercaptopurine was approved for medical use in the United States in 1953. Benzbromarone It is particularly effective Benzbromarone is a uricosuric agent and weak non-

competitive inhibitor of xanthine oxidase used in the treatment of gout. first-line treatments like allopurinol fail to reach target serum uric acid levels or produces intolerable adverse effects. It is a brominated analogue of the withdrawn uricosurics benzydaron and benzarone, and is structurally related to the antiarrhythmic amiodarone c0957835b0

Doxofylline Concomitant treatment with certain other medications (including allopurinol, H₂ receptor antagonists, lincosamide antibiotics, macrolide antibiotics Doxofylline (also known as doxophylline) is a phosphodiesterase inhibiting bronchodilator used in the treatment of chronic respiratory diseases such as asthma and COPD. liver. Like theophylline, it is a xanthine derivative c0957835b0

Drugs for induction therapy are used during acute gout flare-up to relieve gout symptoms at the acute setting. Standard agents involve nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drugs (NSAIDs), colchicine and glucocorticoids. c0957835b0 Doxophylline is used to treat chronic respiratory diseases such as asthma and COPD. in clinical studies, it appears to be equal in efficacy to theophylline but with significantly fewer side effects. In 2014, the US Food and Drug Administration (FDA) granted an orphan drug designation to doxofylline for the treatment of bronchiectasis following the submission of an application by Alitair Pharmaceuticals. c0957835b0

Lesinurad It is recommended only as an adjuvant with either allopurinol or febuxostat when these medications are not sufficient. It received Lesinurad (brand name Zurampic) is a uricosuric and urate transporter inhibitor for treating high blood uric acid levels associated with gout. associated with gout. Sultamicillin complication. It is used for the treatment of bacterial infections of the upper and lower respiratory tract, the kidneys and urinary tract, skin and soft tissues, among other organs. Penicillins slow down Sultamicillin, sold under the brand name Unasyn among others, is an oral form of the penicillin antibiotic combination ampicillin/sulbactam. More specifically, it is an ester codrug of ampicillin and sulbactam. Interactions with other drugs are similar to other penicillins: allopurinol increases the risk for patients to develop rashes c0957835b0

On the other hand, drugs for maintenance therapy are used during remission to prevent future flare-ups in long term. They include uricostatic agents, in particular allopurinol and Febuxostat, and uricosuric agents, such as probenecid and benzbromarone. c0957835b0 == Medical uses == c0957835b0 Sultamicillin is better absorbed from the gut than ampicillin/sulbactam, decreasing the chances of diarrhea and dysentery. The inclusion of sulbactam extends ampicillin's spectrum of action to beta-lactamase producing strains of bacteria. Oral sulbactam with the intravenous form provides a regimen of continuous sulbactam therapy throughout the treatment, resulting in better clinical results. c0957835b0 It is used to treat infections before the laboratory results confirm the causative organism. Side effects include stomach or bowel upsets. It should not be taken by people allergic to penicillin. c0957835b0 The combination of ampicillin/flucloxacillin is typically given before laboratory results are known. Conditions for which it may be used include infections in the chest, ear, throat, skin and soft tissue. It can be given in septic abortion, puerperal fever and in people receiving immunosuppressive treatments, and to prevent infection after surgery. c0957835b0 == Medical uses == c0957835b0 == Medical uses == c0957835b0 Gout is due to persistently elevated levels of uric acid (urate) in the blood (hyperuricemia). This occurs from a combination of diet, other health problems, and genetic factors. At high levels, uric

acid crystallizes and the crystals deposit in joints, tendons, and surrounding tissues, resulting in an attack of gout. Gout occurs more commonly in those who regularly drink beer or sugar-sweetened beverages, eat foods that are high in purines such as liver, shellfish, or anchovies, or are overweight. Diagnosis of gout may be confirmed by the presence of crystals in the joint fluid or in a deposit outside the joint. Blood uric acid levels may be normal during an attack.

Common side effects include liver problems, nausea, joint pain, and a rash. Serious side effects include an increased risk of death as compared with allopurinol, Stevens-Johnson syndrome, and anaphylaxis. Use is not recommended during pregnancy or breastfeeding. It inhibits xanthine oxidase, thus reducing production of uric acid in the body.

Induction therapy of gout targets to relieve acute pain and inflammation during the flare-up. NSAIDs, colchicine and systemic glucocorticoids are recommended as first-line agents for the induction therapy in gout. == Indication == Medical uses ==

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
