When sold, Duke's had a 55% market share in the segments it operated in Mumbai

and Maharashtra. The sale was reportedly led by Darius Pandole. Honey Honey is made and stored to nourish bee colonies. This refinement takes place both within individual bees, through regurgitation and enzymatic activity, and during storage in the hive, through water evaporation that concentrates the honey's sugars until it is thick and viscous.
