Reflex syncope Before an affected person passes out, there may be sweating, a decreased ability to see, or ringing in the ears. possibly prevent future vasovagal responses; however, for some individuals medication is ineffective and they will continue to have fainting episodes Reflex syncope is a brief loss of consciousness due to a neurologically induced drop in blood pressure or heart rate. Phobic level responses to injections cause sufferers to avoid inoculations, blood tests, and in the more severe cases, all medical care. bc87de9dfd One theory for the predominance of fainting couches is that women were actually fainting because their corsets were laced too tightly, thus restricting blood flow. By preventing movement of the ribs, corsets restricted airflow to the lungs and, as a result, if the wearer exerted themselves to the point of needing large quantities of oxygen and was unable to fully inflate the lungs, this could lead to fainting. Vasovagal syncope is typically triggered by seeing blood, pain, emotional stress, or prolonged standing. Situational syncope is often triggered by urination, swallowing, or coughing. Carotid sinus syncope is due to pressure on the carotid sinus in the neck. The underlying mechanism involves the nervous system slowing the heart rate and dilating blood vessels, resulting in low blood pressure and thus insufficient blood flow to the brain. Diagnosis is based on the symptoms after ruling
