This muscular defect typically results in myalgia (muscle pain), muscle weakness (reduced muscle force), or premature muscle fatigue (initially normal, but declining muscle force). The rash is Rubella, also known as German measles or three-day measles, is a vaccine-preventable infection caused by the rubella virus. Complications may include bleeding problems, testicular swelling, encephalitis, and inflammation of nerves. Symptoms of CRS manifest as problems with the eyes such as cataracts, deafness, as well as affecting the heart and brain. The rash is sometimes itchy and is not as bright as that of measles. Joint pain is common in adults. The disease is often mild, with half of people not realizing that they are infected. Fungal infection There is usually a rash with superficial infection. Fungal infection within the skin or under the skin may present with a lump and skin changes. Systemic fungal infections are more serious and include cryptococcosis, histoplasmosis, pneumocystis pneumonia, aspergillosis and mucormycosis. Pneumonia-like symptoms or meningitis may occur with a deeper or systemic infection. The bumps then scabbed over and fell off, leaving scars. The disease was transmitted from one person to another primarily through prolonged face-to-face contact with an infected person or rarely via contaminated objects. Prevention was achieved mainly through the smallpox vaccine. Once the disease had developed, certain antiviral medications could have helped, but such medications did not become available until after the disease was eradicated. The risk of death was about 30%, with higher rates among babies.
