The London Eye adjoins the western end of Jubilee Gardens (previously the site of the former Dome of Discovery), on the South Bank of the River Thames between Westminster Bridge and Hungerford Bridge beside County Hall, in the London Borough of Lambeth. The Sony-owned Hawk-Eye system was originally developed in the United Kingdom by Paul Hawkins. The system was first implemented in 2001 for television broadcasts, where it was used to analyze leg before wicket decisions in cricket. It works via the use of up to ten high-performance cameras, normally positioned on the underside of the stadium roof, which track the ball from different angles. The video from the cameras is then triangulated and combined to create a three-dimensional representation of the ball's trajectory. Although not infallible, Hawk-Eye is advertised to be accurate to within 2.6 mm (100 thou).
