The birth rate (along with mortality and migration rates) is used to calculate population growth. The estimated average population may be taken as the mid-year population. Although this is a subtle point, it has sometimes played an important role in wage bargaining negotiations by trade unions. For an extreme example, workers might work extremely hard in an enterprise which nevertheless operates at a loss. The optical reproduction ratio is the subject size captured on the film frame (or image sensor) compared to the actual subject size, and is a function of the lens design. The optical magnification m is equivalent to optical reproduction ratio. For example, an optical reproduction ratio of 1:10 means the image is recorded at 1/10th of the actual subject size, and the equivalent optical magnification is 1/10 $\times$, 0.10 $\times$, or 10%. In the strictest definition, a macro photograph is one in which the size of the image captured is life-size or larger (i.e., optical reproduction ratio $\geq 1:1$) compared to the original subject. ddcfd93d94
