A-Amanitin The oral LD50 of amanitin is 100 µg/kg for rats. It is also found in the mushrooms *Galerina marginata*, *Lepiota subincarnata* and *Conocybe rugosa*. Ezetimibe Use in pregnancy and breastfeeding is of unclear safety. Ezetimibe Ezetimibe, sold under the brand name Zetia among others, is a medication used to treat high blood cholesterol and certain other lipid abnormalities. Ezetimibe works by decreasing cholesterol absorption in the intestines. Generally it is used together with dietary changes and a statin. It is taken by mouth. muscle breakdown. Alone, it is less preferred than a statin. Thalassemias are genetic disorders. Alpha thalassemia is caused by deficient production of the alpha globin component of hemoglobin, while beta thalassemia is a deficiency in the beta globin component. The severity of alpha and beta thalassemia depends on how many of the four genes for alpha globin or two genes for beta globin are faulty. Diagnosis is typically by blood tests including a complete blood count, special hemoglobin tests, and genetic tests. Diagnosis may occur before birth through prenatal testing. 3744908fb6 Beta thalassemia occurs due to a mutation of the HBB gene leading to deficient production of the hemoglobin subunit beta-globin; the severity of the disease depends on the nature of the mutation, and whether or not the mutation is homozygous. The body's inability to construct beta-globin leads to reduced or zero production of adult hemoglobin thus causing anemia. The other component of hemoglobin, alpha-globin, accumulates in excess leading to ineffective production of red blood cells, increased hemolysis, and iron overload.
