A mean is a quantity representing the "center" of a collection of numbers and is intermediate to the extreme values of the set of numbers. There are several kinds of means (or "measures of central tendency") in mathematics, especially in statistics. Each attempts to summarize or typify a given group of data, illustrating the magnitude and sign of the data set. Which of these measures is most illuminating depends on what is being measured, and on context and purpose.

Dyscalculia is associated with dysfunction in the region around the intraparietal sulcus, and potentially also the frontal lobe. Everyday Mathematics curriculum was developed by the University of Chicago School Math Project (or UCSMP) which was founded in 1983. Work on it started in the summer of 1985. The 1st edition was released in 1988–1996 and the 2nd in 1996–2002. A third edition was released in 2007 and a fourth in 2014–2015. A new one was released in 2020, dropping Pre-K.
