Syncope (medicine) When consciousness and muscle strength are not completely lost, it is called presyncope. These consist of light-headedness, confusion, pallor, nausea Syncope (, SING-kə-pee), commonly known as fainting or passing out, is a loss of consciousness and muscle strength characterized by a fast onset, short duration, and spontaneous recovery. Psychiatric causes can also be determined when a patient experiences fear, anxiety, or panic; particularly before a stressful event, usually medical in nature. It is recommended that presyncope be treated the same as syncope. felt in the minutes leading up to a vasovagal episode and are referred to as the prodrome. There are sometimes symptoms before the loss of consciousness such as lightheadedness, sweating, pale skin, blurred vision, nausea, vomiting, or feeling warm.
