Picaridin Picaridin, also known as icaridin, is an insect repellent that can be used directly on skin or clothing. Unlike DEET, picaridin does not dissolve plastics, synthetics or sealants, is odorless and non-greasy and presents a lower risk of toxicity when used with sunscreen, as it may reduce skin absorption of both compounds. It has broad efficacy against various arthropods such as mosquitos, ticks, gnats, flies and fleas, and is almost colorless and odorless. It has broad efficacy against various arthropods Picaridin, also known as icaridin, is an insect repellent that can be used directly on skin or clothing. A study performed in 2010 showed that picaridin spray and cream at the 20% concentration provided 12 hours of protection against ticks 69152c8ba6

== Effectiveness == Some insect repellents are insecticides (bug killers), but most simply discourage insects and send them flying or crawling away. The name picaridin was proposed as an International Nonproprietary Name (INN) to the World Health Organization (WHO), but the official name that has been approved by the WHO is icaridin. The chemical is part of the piperidine family, along with many pharmaceuticals and alkaloids such as piperine, which gives black pepper its spicy taste.

Carroll was awarded his Ph.D. in biology at the University of Utah in 1990. He gained his Master of Science in 1983 at the University of Oklahoma, graduating in 1981 with a Bachelor of Science in ecology and behavioral biology (magna cum laude) at the University of Minnesota. The product's original advertising tagline from its introduction in 1956 until 2016, "Raid Kills Bugs Dead", was created by the advertising agency Foote, Cone & Belding. The phrase itself is often attributed to the poet Lew Welch, who worked for the agency at the time. Nootkatone is produced commercially from valencene, another more abundant sesquiterpene. For protection against ticks and mosquito bites, the U.S. Centers for Disease Control (CDC) recommends DEET, icaridin (picaridin, KBR 3023), oil of lemon eucalyptus (OLE), para-menthane-diol (PMD), IR3535 and 2-undecanone with the caveat that higher percentages of the active ingredient provide longer protection. Citronella oil has strong antifungal properties. The brand was sold as Ridsect for Malaysian market. == Seed treatments == == Types == A 2018 systematic review found no consistent performance difference between DEET and Picaridin in field studies and concluded that they are equally preferred mosquito repellents, noting that 50% DEET offers longer protection but is not available in some countries. The line was first used in commerce in 1966 and was trademarked in 1986. Noted animation director Tex Avery was the producer of the first "Kills Bugs Dead" commercials. Nootkatone was originally isolated from the wood of the Alaskan yellow cedar, *Cupressus nootkatensis*. It is also an effective repellent or insecticide Nootkatone is an organic compound, a sesquiterpenoid, which means that it is a C₁₅ derivative that also contains an oxygen-containing functional group (a ketone).
