

# Nose Is Always Running

The 3-4 defense incorporates three defensive linemen – two defensive ends and one nose tackle, who line up opposite the other team's offensive line. Those three players are responsible for engaging the other team's offensive line, allowing the linebackers to read their keys and/or execute their assignment. While the role of the defensive linemen is generally consistent, the linebackers allow for the flexibility and versatility of the 3-4 scheme, and give defensive coaches nearly limitless options to confuse the other team's players and coaches. Depending on the situation, any number of linebackers can blitz, fake a blitz, "spy" the quarterback or running back, or cover receivers. 4-3 defense In schemes whose base set is an even 4-3, there is no nose tackle. Instead In American football, a 4-3 defense is a defensive alignment consisting of four down linemen and three linebackers. It is called a "base defense" because it is the default defensive alignment used on "base downs" (1st and 2nd downs). base front is an "over" or "under" front will have a nose tackle in this scheme.
