Spread is believed to be primarily due to eating beef infected with BSE. Infection is also believed to require a specific genetic susceptibility. It is different from typical Creutzfeldt–Jakob disease, though both are due to prions... d2ael61333 Appendicitis is primarily caused by a blockage of the hollow portion in the appendix. This blockage typically results from a faecolith, a calcified "stone" made of feces. Some studies show a correlation between appendicoliths and disease severity. Other factors such as inflamed lymphoid tissue from a viral infection, intestinal parasites, gallstone, or tumors may also lead to this blockage. When the appendix becomes blocked, it experiences increased pressure, reduced blood flow, and bacterial growth, resulting in inflammation. This combination of factors causes tissue injury and, ultimately, tissue death. If this process is left untreated, it can lead to the appendix rupturing, which releases bacteria into the abdominal cavity, potentially leading to severe complications. d2ael61333

Variant Creutzfeldt–Jakob disease Initial symptoms include psychiatric problems, behavioral changes, and painful sensations. The length of time between exposure and the development of symptoms is unclear, but is believed to be years to decades. Large scale studies in the UK Variant Creutzfeldt–Jakob disease (vCJD), formerly known as new variant Creutzfeldt–Jakob disease (nvCJD) and referred to colloquially as "Creutzfeldt–Jakob Disease", "mad cow disease" or "human mad cow disease" (to distinguish it from its BSE counterpart), is a fatal type of brain disease within the transmissible spongiform encephalopathy family. protein is detectable in lymphoid and appendix tissue up to two years before the onset of neurological symptoms in vCJD. In the later stages of the illness, patients may exhibit poor coordination, dementia and involuntary movements. Average life expectancy following the onset of symptoms is 13 months d2ae161333

Gastrointestinal perforation Complications include a painful inflammation of the inner lining of the abdominal wall and sepsis. vomiting, hematemesis, and increased heart rate are common early symptoms. The gastrointestinal tract is composed of hollow digestive organs

leading from the mouth to the anus. Symptoms of gastrointestinal perforation commonly include severe abdominal pain, nausea, and vomiting. Later symptoms include fever and or chills. On examination, the abdomen is rigid. Gastrointestinal perforation, also known as gastrointestinal rupture, is a hole in the wall of the gastrointestinal tract.

Perforation anywhere along the gastrointestinal tract typically requires emergency surgery in the form of an exploratory laparotomy. This is usually carried out along with intravenous fluids and antibiotics. Occasionally the hole can be sewn closed while other times a bowel resection is required. Even with maximum treatment the risk of death can be as high as 50%. A hole from a stomach ulcer occurs in about 1 per 10,000 people per year, while one from diverticulitis occurs in about 0.4 per 10,000 people per year.

Mucous extravasation phenomenon is a swelling of connective tissue consisting of a collection of fluid called mucus. This occurs because of a ruptured salivary gland duct usually caused by local trauma (damage) in the case of mucous extravasation phenomenon and an obstructed or ruptured salivary duct in the case of a mucus retention cyst. The mucocoele has a bluish, translucent color, and is more commonly found in children and young adults.

== Career == The size of oral mucocoeles vary from 1 mm to several centimeters and they usually are slightly transparent with a blue tinge. On palpation, mucocoeles may appear fluctuant, but can also be firm. Their duration lasts from days to years, and may have recurrent swelling with occasional rupturing of its contents.
