Initially it referred only to specific sexual needs, but he later expanded the concept to a universal desire, with the id being its "great reservoir". They carry risks like neurotoxicity, withdrawal, and complications from untested drug combinations. Their use is controversial, with critics citing overmedicalization, placebo effects, and potential long-term brain changes. Untreated mental illness also poses cognitive risks.
