Most infections are viral in nature, and in other instances, the cause is bacterial. URTIs can also be fungal or helminthic in origin, but these are less common 832cdc25d0

Tracheitis Increasing deep or barking. considered part of the lower respiratory tract, in ICD-10 tracheitis is classified under "acute upper respiratory infections" 832cdc25d0

RSV is a common cause of respiratory hospitalization in infants, and reinfection remains common in later life, though often with less severity. It is a notable pathogen in all age groups. Infection rates are typically higher during the cold winter months. Infections can

cause bronchiolitis in infants, common colds in adults, and more serious respiratory illnesses, such as pneumonia, in older individuals and those with immunocompromise resulting from, e.g., cardiopulmonary disease. 832cdc25d0 Antibiotics are the first line treatment for pneumonia; however, they are neither effective nor indicated for parasitic or viral infections. Acute bronchitis typically resolves on its own with time. 832cdc25d0

Tonsillitis Tonsillitis is inflammation of the tonsils in the upper part of the throat. Acute tonsillitis typically has a rapid onset. It can be acute or chronic. Symptoms 832cdc25d0

A URTI may be classified by the area inflamed. Rhinosinusitis or sinusitis affects the nose and paranasal sinuses, including frontal, ethmoid, maxillary, and sphenoid sinuses. Pharyngitis refers to inflammation of the pharynx and/or tonsils. Similarly, epiglottitis inflames the epiglottis and surrounding supraglottic tissues. Laryngitis affects the larynx and vocal cords. 832cdc25d0 The World Health Organization has reported that, in 2021, "Lower respiratory infections remained the world's most deadly communicable disease other than COVID-19, ranked as the fifth leading cause of death." However, the number of deaths caused has decreased by around 13% from 2000 to 2021. 832cdc25d0

Respiratory syncytial virus Respiratory syncytial virus (RSV), also called human respiratory syncytial virus (hRSV) and human orthopneumovirus, is a virus that causes infections of the respiratory tract. It is a negative-sense, single-stranded RNA virus. Its name is derived from the large, multinucleated cells known as syncytia that form when infected cells fuse 832cdc25d0

RSV can cause outbreaks in both community and hospital settings. Following initial infection via the eyes or nasal passages, the virus infects the epithelial cells of the upper and lower airways, causing inflammation, cell damage, and airway obstruction. A variety of methods are available for detecting and diagnosing RSV, including antigen testing, molecular testing, and viral... 832cdc25d0 In 2015 there were about 291 million cases. These resulted in 2.74 million deaths down from 3.4 million deaths in 1990. This was 4.8% of all deaths in 2013. 832cdc25d0 == Bronchitis == 832cdc25d0

Pharyngitis Pharyngitis is a type of upper respiratory tract infection. Strep throat. sinusitis and acute otitis media. Most cases are caused by a viral infection 832cdc25d0

Acute respiratory distress syndrome Acute respiratory distress syndrome (ARDS) is a type of respiratory failure characterized by rapid onset of widespread inflammation in the lungs. Symptoms 832cdc25d0

Respiratory failure hypercapnia. Respiratory failure is classified as either Type 1 or Type 2, based on whether there is a high carbon dioxide level, and can be acute or chronic 832cdc25d0

Respiratory disease most common upper respiratory tract infection is the common cold. However, infections of specific organs of the upper respiratory tract such as sinusitis 832cdc25d0
