

Does Hyaluronic Acid Help Acne

Susceptibility to acne is primarily genetic in 80% of cases. The roles of diet and cigarette smoking in the condition are unclear, and neither cleanliness nor exposure to sunlight are associated with acne. Bicalutamide is used primarily in the treatment of early and advanced prostate cancer.
