Devils are not monogamous... 4a374da97e The coolant is used to lower the temperature of a branding iron such that its application to shaved skin will permanently alter hair follicles. The intense cold destroys the pigmentation apparatus in the animal's hair follicles, leaving all subsequent hair growth without color. This creates a high-contrast, permanent mark in the shape of the branding iron's head. A longer application of the cold iron can also permanently remove hair and is used on white or pale animals. Visceral fat, also known as organ fat or intra-abdominal fat, is located inside the peritoneal cavity, packed in between internal organs and torso, as opposed to subcutaneous fat, which is found underneath the skin, and intramuscular fat, which is found interspersed in skeletal muscle. Visceral fat is composed of several adipose depots including mesenteric, epididymal white adipose tissue (EWAT), and perirenal fat. An excess of adipose visceral fat is known as central obesity, the "pot belly" or "beer belly" effect, in which the abdomen protrudes excessively. Corticosteroid The two main classes of corticosteroids – glucocorticoids and mineralocorticoids – are involved in a wide range of physiological processes, including stress response, immune response, and regulation of inflammation, carbohydrate metabolism, protein catabolism, blood electrolyte levels, and behavior. Glucocorticoids such as cortisol affect carbohydrate, fat, and protein metabolism, and have anti-inflammatory, immunosuppressive, anti-proliferative, and vasoconstrictive Corticosteroids are a class of steroid hormones that are produced in the adrenal cortex of vertebrates, and also their synthetic analogues 4a374da97e

Pituitary pars intermedia dysfunction It is most commonly seen in older animals, and is classically associated with the formation of a long, wavy coat (hirsutism) and chronic laminitis. and increased urination Pot-bellied appearance Weight loss Redistribution of fat, leading to bulging supraorbital fat pad, a "cresty" neck, and fat over Pituitary pars intermedia dysfunction (PPID), or equine Cushing's disease, is an endocrine disease affecting the pituitary gland of horses 4a374da97e

Unlike the human and canine forms of Cushing's disease, which most commonly affect the pars distalis region of the pituitary gland, equine Cushing's disease is a result of hyperplasia or adenoma formation in the pars intermedia. This adenoma then secretes excessive amounts of normal products, leading to clinical signs. 4a374da97e

Some common naturally occurring steroid hormones are cortisol (C₂₁H₃₀O₅), corticosterone (C₂₁H₃₀O₄), cortisone (C₂₁H₂₈O₅) and aldosterone (C₂₁H₂₈O₅) (cortisone and aldosterone are isomers). The main corticosteroids produced by the adrenal cortex are cortisol and aldosterone. 4a374da97e

Adipose tissue Visceral fat can be caused by excess cortisol levels. It also contains the stromal vascular fraction of cells including preadipocytes, fibroblasts, vascular endothelial cells and a variety of immune cells such as adipose tissue macrophages. from the buttocks, hips and thighs to the waist; later fat is stored in the abdomen. Its main role is to store energy in the form of lipids, although it also cushions and insulates the body. Stretch marks Some have suggested that relaxin and estrogen combined with higher levels of cortisol during pregnancy can cause an accumulation of mucopolysaccharides Stretch marks, also known as striae () or striae distensae, are a form of scarring on the skin with an off-color hue. Striae are caused by tearing of the dermis during periods of rapid growth of the body, such as during puberty or pregnancy, in which they usually form during the last trimester. Over time, they may diminish or change in appearance, but will not disappear completely. Pregnancy-related striae are known as striae gravidarum. Striae may also be influenced by the hormonal changes associated with puberty, pregnancy, bodybuilding, or hormone replacement therapy. Usually on the belly, these striae also commonly occur on the breasts, thighs, hips, lower back, and buttocks. Once they have formed, there is no clearly effective treatment, though various methods have been attempted and studied. striae formation.
