A WHtR of over 0.5 signifies an increased risk; a 2010 systematic review of published studies concluded that "WHtR may be advantageous because it avoids the need for age-, sex- and ethnic-specific boundary values". According to World Health Organization guidance, the waist circumference is usually measured midway between the lower rib and the iliac crest. == Physiology == Size inconsistency has existed since at least 1937.
