As vaccine programs began, the World Health Organization predicted in June 2021 that 47 of Africa's 54 nations would fall short of the aim of vaccinating 10% of their people by September 2021. COVID-19 vaccination in Australia The Therapeutic Goods Administration (TGA) approved four vaccines for Australian use in 2021: the Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine on 25 January, the Oxford-AstraZeneca vaccine on 16 February, Janssen vaccine on 25 June and the Moderna vaccine on 9 August. Front-line workers and aged care staff and residents had priority for being inoculated, before a gradual phased release to less-vulnerable and lower-risk population groups throughout 2021. Although approved for use, the Janssen vaccine was not included in the Australian vaccination program as of June 2021

On 15 July 2021, WHO Africa's coordinator for immunization and vaccines development reported that African nations had destroyed some 450,000 vaccine doses due to their expiry dates. He cited Malawi, South Sudan, Liberia, Mauritania, Gambia, Sierra Leone, Guinea, Comoros and the Democratic Republic of Congo as examples.

International Certificate of Vaccination or Prophylaxis Various schemes for health passports or vaccination certificates have been proposed for people who have been vaccinated against COVID-19. As a travel document, it is a kind of medical passport that is recognised internationally and may be required for entry to certain countries where there are increased health risks for travellers. COVID-19 vaccination in the Republic of Ireland The COVID-19 vaccination programme in the Republic of Ireland is an ongoing mass immunisation campaign that began on 29 December 2020 in response to the COVID-19 pandemic in Ireland. Ireland's vaccination rollout has been praised as one of the most successful rollouts in the world and was ranked number one in the European Union in terms of its percentage of adult population fully vaccinated, and was also ranked number one in the EU for the number of booster vaccines administered

The ICVP is not an immunity passport; the primary difference is that vaccination certificates such as the ICVP incentivise individuals to obtain vaccination against a disease, while immunity passports incentivise individuals to get infected with and recover from a disease.

COVID-19 vaccination in the United States The COVID-19 vaccination campaign in the United States was a mass immunization campaign for the COVID-19 pandemic in the United States. It was not until April 19, 2021, that all U. states had opened vaccine eligibility to residents aged 16 and over. The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) first granted emergency use authorization to the Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine on December 10, 2020, and mass vaccinations began four days later. On May 10, 2021, the FDA approved the Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine for adolescents aged 12 to 15. The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) granted full approval to the Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine for individuals aged 16 and over. The Moderna vaccine was granted emergency use authorization on December 17, 2020, and the Janssen (Johnson & Johnson) vaccine was granted emergency use authorization on February 27, 2021

As of 20 February 2023, 12,744,694 vaccine doses have been administered, of which 4,107,865 people have received at least one dose, 3,819,227 have received their second dose and 4,817,602 have received a booster dose.
