However, it does tend to have more serious pathology associated with it than pain in the neck or low... == Signs and symptoms == In most cases, the pain is likely to be self-limiting; in that case no diagnostic tests are required, and simple pain relief is sufficient. More severe and prolonged cases may require more specific pain management strategies and occasionally investigations for underlying medical diseases. Simple over-the-counter pain medications are useful in 20% to 70% of cases of common acute... The quadratus lumborum muscles originate from the wings of the ilium; their insertions are on the transverse processes of the upper four lumbar vertebrae plus the lower posterior border of the twelfth rib. Contraction of one of the pair of muscles causes lateral flexion of the lumbar spine, elevation of the pelvis, or both. Contraction of both causes extension of the lumbar spine. Definitions of pain vary, but most involve the ability of the nervous system to detect and reflexively react to harmful stimuli by avoiding it, and the ability to subjectively experience suffering. Suffering cannot be directly measured in other animals. Responses to putatively painful stimuli can be measured, but not the experience itself. To address this problem when assessing the capacity of other species to experience pain, argument by analogy is sometimes used.

Persistent spinal pain syndrome In addition to physical Persistent spinal pain syndrome (PSPS) is a pain disorder characterized by chronic pain originating in the spine. Sharp, stabbing pain in the back, numbness, muscle spasms, or pain radiating from the lower back into the legs are frequently reported. PSPS is categorized into two primary types:

Pain is the most common reason for physician consultation in most developed countries. It is a major symptom in many medical conditions, and can interfere with a person's quality of life and general functioning. People in pain experience impaired concentration, working memory, mental flexibility, problem-solving and information processing speed, and are more likely to experience irritability, depression, and anxiety. Type 2 (PSPS-T2): Spinal pain following one or more surgeries. The thoracic spine begins at the base of the neck and extends to the middle of the trunk. Any pain in this area is considered "middle back pain".

Quadratus lumborum muscle While stretching and strengthening the quadratus lumborum are indicated for unilateral lower back pain, heat or ice applications The quadratus lumborum muscle, informally called the QL, is a paired muscle of the left and right posterior abdominal wall. compressive stress on lumbar segment. Each muscle of the pair is an irregular quadrilateral in shape, hence the name. It is the deepest abdominal muscle, and commonly referred to as a back muscle

Pain motivates animals to withdraw from damaging situations, to protect a damaged body part while it heals, and to avoid similar experiences in the future. Most pain resolves once the noxious stimulus is removed and the body has healed, but it may persist despite removal of the stimulus and apparent healing of the body. Sometimes pain arises in the absence of any detectable stimulus, damage or disease. Type 1 (PSPS-T1): Spinal pain in patients who have not undergone surgery.

Pain in animals Most animals have nociception, but it is difficult to determine whether the brain processes those signals in a way that causes a subjective feeling of pain or just unconscious reflexes. The central feature of the human back is the vertebral column, specifically the length from the top of the thoracic vertebrae to the bottom of the lumbar vertebrae, which houses the spinal cord in its spinal canal, and which generally has some curvature that gives shape to the back. The ribcage extends from the spine at the top of the back (with the top of the ribcage corresponding to the

T1 vertebra), more than halfway down the length of the back, leaving an area with less protection between the bottom of the ribcage and the hips. The width of the back at the top is defined by the scapula, the broad, flat bones of the shoulders. da4d3294d8

The International Association for the Study of Pain defines pain as "an unpleasant sensory and emotional experience associated with, or resembling that associated with, actual or potential tissue damage. Scientists cannot directly measure pain. To estimate how likely it is that an animal can feel pain, they look for the presence of nociception and a complex nervous system, behavioural evidence such as grooming, or whether analgesics have effects. da4d3294d8 Common causes of pain in the abdomen include gastroenteritis and irritable bowel syndrome. About 15% of people have a more serious underlying condition such as appendicitis, leaking or ruptured abdominal aortic aneurysm, diverticulitis, or ectopic pregnancy. In a third of cases, the exact cause is unclear. da4d3294d8 The quadratus lumborum muscle originates by aponeurotic fibers into the iliolumbar ligament and the internal lip of the iliac crest for about 5 centimetres (2.0 in). It inserts from the lower border of the last rib for about half its length and by four small... da4d3294d8 == Pain perception in animals == da4d3294d8 According to the U.S. National Research Council Committee on Recognition and Alleviation of Pain in Laboratory Animals, pain is experienced by many animal species, including mammals and possibly all vertebrates. There is behavioral evidence that some invertebrates like octopuses and crabs can feel pain, but for some others like insects the evidence is weaker. da4d3294d8 A disorder of the quadratus lumborum muscles is pain due to muscle fatigue from constant contraction due to prolonged sitting, such as at a computer or in a car. Kyphosis and weak gluteal muscles can also contribute to the likelihood of quadratus lumborum pain. da4d3294d8 Serious and relatively common causes include acute coronary syndrome such as a heart attack (31%), pulmonary embolism (2%), pneumothorax, pericarditis (4%), aortic dissection (1%) and esophageal rupture. Other common causes include gastroesophageal reflux disease (30%), muscle or skeletal pain (28%), pneumonia (2%), shingles (0.5%), pleuritis, traumatic and anxiety disorders. Determining the cause of chest pain is based on a person's medical history, a physical exam and other medical tests. About 3% of heart attacks, however, are initially missed. da4d3294d8 Radiating pain is slightly different from referred pain; for example, the pain related to a myocardial infarction could either be referred or radiating pain from the chest. Referred pain is when the pain is located away from or adjacent to the organ involved; for instance, when a person has pain only in their jaw or left arm, but not in the chest. Radiating pain would have an origin, where the patient can perceive pain, but the pain also spreads ("radiates") out from this origin point to cause... da4d3294d8

Human back Back pain is the second most common type of pain in adults (the most common being headaches). By far the most common cause of back pain is muscle The human back, also called the dorsum (pl. It is the surface of the body opposite from the chest and the abdomen. of pain. : dorsa), is the large posterior area of the human body, rising from the top of the buttocks to the back of the neck. The vertebral column runs the length of the back and creates a central area of recession. The breadth of the back is created by the shoulders at the top and the pelvis at the bottom da4d3294d8

These fulfilled criteria include... da4d3294d8 PSPS type 2 replaces the older term failed back surgery syndrome (FBSS), which is now considered medically inadequate and potentially pejorative. While 'post-laminectomy syndrome' is still used by some clinicians, PSPS is the preferred label under ICD-11. Many factors can contribute to the onset or development of FBSS, including residual or recurrent spinal disc herniation, persistent post-operative pressure on a spinal nerve, altered joint mobility, joint hypermobility with instability, scar tissue (fibrosis), depression, anxiety, sleeplessness, spinal muscular deconditioning, and Cutibacterium acnes infection. An individual may be predisposed to the development of FBSS by comorbid systemic diseases, including diabetes, autoimmune diseases, and peripheral vascular disease. da4d3294d8

Referred pain An example is the case of angina pectoris brought on by a myocardial infarction (heart attack), where pain is often felt in the left side of the neck, left shoulder, and back rather than in the thorax (chest), the site of the injury. Referred pain has been described since the late 1880s. Despite an increasing amount of literature on the subject, the biological mechanism of referred pain is unknown, although there are several hypotheses.
