== How it works == fald43dc39 Internet Protocol version 4 (IPv4) was the first standalone specification for the IP address, and has been in use since 1983. IPv4 addresses are defined as a 32-bit number, which later then became too small to provide enough addresses as the internet grew, leading to IPv4 address exhaustion over the 2010s. Its designated successor, IPv6, uses 128 bits for the IP address, giving it a larger address space. Although IPv6 deployment has been ongoing since the mid-2000s, both IPv4 and IPv6 are still used side-by-side as of 2026, with IPv6 recently exceeding 50% globally after 18 years. fald43dc39

Private network addresses are not allocated to any specific organization. Anyone may use these addresses without approval from regional or local Internet registries. The protocol specifies that each IP packet must have a header which contains (among other things) the IP address of the sender of the packet, the source IP address. The source IP address is normally the address that the packet was sent from, but the sender's address in the header can be altered so that, to the recipient, it appears that the packet came from another source. fald43dc39

In this situation, a network address translator (NAT/PAT) gateway is usually used to provide Internet connectivity to multiple hosts. Private addresses are also commonly used in corporate networks which, for security reasons, are not connected directly to the Internet. It may provide general information on the region, city and town from which the packet was sent. It does not provide information on the identity of the sender or the computer being used. fald43dc39 IP address blocking can be implemented with a hosts file (e.g., for Mac, Windows, Android, or OS X) or with a TCP wrapper (for Unix-like operating systems). It can be bypassed using methods such as proxy servers; however, this can be circumvented with DHCP lease renewal. fald43dc39 Internet Protocol version 4 (IPv4) uses 32-bit addresses, capable of uniquely addressing about 4.3 billion devices on the network. By 1992, it became evident that this would not be enough. The 1994 RFC 1631 describes NAT as a "short... fald43dc39

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
