Maximum parsimony is an intuitive and simple criterion, and it is popular for this reason. However, although it is easy to score a phylogenetic tree (by counting the total number of character-state changes), finding the single most-parsimonious tree is computationally difficult because researchers must search amongst all possible configurations. For a small number of taxa (i.e., fewer than nine) it is possible to do an exhaustive search, in which every possible tree is scored, and the best one is selected.
