Streptococcus pneumoniae resides asymptotically in healthy carriers, typically colonizing the respiratory tract, sinuses, and nasal cavity. However, in susceptible individuals with weaker immune systems, such as the elderly and young children, the bacterium may become pathogenic and spread to other locations to cause disease. It spreads by direct person-to-person contact via respiratory droplets and by auto-inoculation in persons carrying the bacteria in their upper respiratory tracts. Pericoronitis is often associated with partially erupted and impacted mandibular third molars (lower wisdom teeth), often occurring at the age of wisdom tooth eruption (15-26). Such an infection can be acquired in a hospital, nursing home, rehabilitation facility, outpatient clinic, diagnostic laboratory or other clinical settings. Hydrogen peroxide is effective against A hospital-acquired infection (HAI), also known as a nosocomial infection (from Greek nosokomeion "hospital, infirmary," from nósos "disease" + koméō "to tend, care for," with locative suffix -eion), is an infection that is acquired in a hospital or other healthcare facility. The use of hydrogen peroxide vapor has been clinically proven to reduce infection rates and risk of acquisition. To encompass both hospital and non-hospital settings, it is sometimes instead called a healthcare-associated infection e1700c6150

Major components of earwax include cerumen, produced by a type of modified sweat gland, and sebum, an oily substance. Both components are made by glands located in the outer ear canal. The chemical composition of earwax includes saturated and unsaturated long chain fatty acids, alcohols, squalene, and cholesterol. Virucides are to be used outside the human body, and as such fall into the category of disinfectants (applied not to the human body) and antiseptics (applied to the surface of skin) for those safe enough.
