In August 1859 he created the slogan for Beecham's Pills: "Worth a guinea a box", considered to be the world's first advertising slogan, which helped the business become a global brand. It was once a constituent of the FTSE 100 Index. GSK (and later, Haleon) still uses the Beechams brand name in the UK for its over-the-counter cold and flu relief products.
