Cerumenolytics are used to soften and break up ear wax. Using a cerumenolytic can reduce the need for flushing the ear with irrigants for wax removal. Additionally, cerumenolytics can also facilitate the manual removal of ear wax. Overall, all cerumenolytics are considered to be equivalent in efficacy. Cerumenolytics are administered directly into the ear, which is a form of topical administration that can be specified as "ototopical." Generally, the use of a cerumenolytic involves instilling several drops of the product into the affected ear once or twice daily for a treatment duration of 3 to 5 days. Each instillation is relatively quick (less than 5 minutes) and can be done either at home or in a clinical setting. However, like all ear wax treatments, the ear wax can reaccumulate in the ear after

treatment, necessitating... It is an additive technique as opposed to more traditional subtracting technique like etching. The ear may be affected by disease, including infection and traumatic damage. Diseases of the ear may lead to hearing loss, tinnitus and balance disorders such as vertigo, although many of these conditions may also be affected by damage to the brain or neural pathways leading from the ear. The ear develops from the first pharyngeal pouch and six small swellings that develop in the early embryo called otic placodes, which are derived from the ectoderm.

A ptosis crutch is bar that is placed along the inside of an eyewire frame that supports the drooping eyelid. The crutch is positioned where the orbital fold would typically be without ptosis. The crutch should create a fold above the eye, tucking the lid in and raising it above the pupil. == Definition and overview == The first recorded mention of the use of earplugs is in the Greek tale *Odyssey*, wherein *Odysseus's* crew is warned about the Sirens that sing from an island they will sail past. *Circe*, their hostess, tells them of the Sirens' bewitching song that makes men drive their boats ashore and perish. She advised *Odysseus* to fashion earplugs for his men from beeswax so they would not be lured to their deaths by the sirens' song. == Process == Acetic acid ear drops may be used as a preventive measure. Treatment of acute cases is typically with antibiotic drops, such as ofloxacin or acetic acid. Steroid drops may be

used in addition to antibiotics. Pain medications such as ibuprofen may be used for the pain....
Once the guitar equipment has been set up onstage, the guitar tech does a soundcheck to ensure that the equipment is working well.
