Non-scarring hair loss This is in contrast to scarring hair loss during which hair follicles are replaced with scar tissue as a result of inflammation. The loss may be sudden or gradual with accompanying stress. There is typically little inflammation and irritation, but hair loss is significant. infections. Depending on the cause, treatment options include: topical minoxidil, oral finasteride, anti-fungal

medications, steroids, hair transplantation Non scarring hair loss, also known as noncicatricial alopecia, is the loss of hair without any scarring being present. Hair loss may be spread throughout the scalp (diffuse) or at certain spots (focal)

Latanoprost Latanoprost is applied as eye drops to the eyes. Onset of effects is usually within four hours, and they last for up to a day. This includes ocular hypertension and open-angle glaucoma. minoxidil and finasteride (TH-07; Triple Hair). Minoxidil The topical solution is often referred to as minoxidil topical solution (MTS) and the topical foam is known as minoxidil topical foam Minoxidil, sold under the brand names Loniten and Rogaine among others, is a medication used for the treatment of high blood pressure and hair loss. Extended-release oral minoxidil and sublingual minoxidil formulations for hair loss are also being studied and developed. Oral minoxidil is used at high doses to treat high blood pressure and at low doses to treat hair loss, while topical minoxidil is used exclusively for hair loss and related indications. It is available as a generic medication

by prescription in oral tablet form and over-the-counter as a topical liquid or foam. absorption of minoxidil. The drug promotes hair growth, but its effects are fully reversible and it does not slow or prevent hair loss. It may also be used off-label to promote beard growth and treat nail problems e9c9fb3b36

The most common cause is androgenetic alopecia, also known as male pattern or female pattern hair loss due to the effects of dihydrotestosterone (DHT) on the hair follicles. A variety of factors may lead to this condition such as hormonal effects, age, diet, autoimmunity, emotional stress, physical stress, drug effects, genetics, or infections. e9c9fb3b36 Alfatradiol is used in form of an ethanolic solution for topical application on the scalp. Similarly to other drugs against alopecia, topical or oral, it has to be applied continuously to prevent further hair loss. Regrowth of hair that was already lost is only possible to a limited extent.

In general, advanced alopecia does not respond well to medical treatment, which has historically been thought to be a consequence of the hair roots being lost. e9c9fb3b36 Finasteride was patented in 1984 and approved for medical use in 1992. It... e9c9fb3b36 Topilutamide is used as a topical medication in the treatment of pattern hair loss in men and women. Topilutamide is approved for cosmetic use in Europe but has not received FDA approval nor approval by the EMA for the treatment of androgenetic alopecia. Finasteride and Minoxidil are currently the only treatments approved for the treatment of this condition. e9c9fb3b36 Topilutamide is a nonsteroidal antiandrogen (NSAA), or an antagonist of the androgen receptor (AR), the biological target of androgens like testosterone and dihydrotestosterone (DHT). e9c9fb3b36 Common side effects include blurry vision, redness of the eye, itchiness, and darkening of the iris. Latanoprost is in the prostaglandin analogue family of medications. It works by increasing the outflow of aqueous fluid from the eyes through

Finasteride and Minoxidil are currently the only treatments approved for the treatment of Topilutamide, known more commonly as fluridil and sold under the brand name Eucapil, is an antiandrogen medication which is used in the treatment of pattern hair loss in men and women. Topilutamide belongs to a class of molecules known as perfluoroacylamido-arylpropanamides. It is used as a topical medication and is applied to the scalp e9c9fb3b36

In addition to DHT, finasteride also inhibits the production of several anticonvulsant neurosteroids including allopregnanolone, androstanediol, and tetrahydrodeoxycorticosterone. e9c9fb3b36 Along with dutasteride, finasteride is a widely dispensed 5 α -reductase inhibitor. As such, it is an antiandrogen that works by

decreasing the production of dihydrotestosterone (DHT) by about 70% in serum, 90% in prostate. e9c9fb3b36

Finasteride Treatment with finasteride slows Finasteride, sold under the brand names Proscar (5 mg) and Propecia (1 mg) among others, is a medication used to treat pattern hair loss and benign prostatic hyperplasia (BPH). States, finasteride and minoxidil are the only two FDA-approved drugs for the treatment of male pattern hair loss as of 2017. It is usually taken orally but there are topical formulations for patients with hair loss, designed to minimize systemic exposure by acting specifically on hair follicles. It can also be used to treat excessive hair growth in women e9c9fb3b36

Pattern hair loss In male-pattern hair loss, the hair loss typically presents itself as either a receding front

hairline, loss of hair on the crown and vertex of the scalp, or a combination of both. therapy, minoxidil, finasteride, dutasteride, or hair transplant surgery. Female-pattern hair loss typically presents as a diffuse thinning of the hair across the entire scalp. The condition is caused by a combination of male sex hormones and genetic factors. Use of finasteride and dutasteride in women is not well-studied and may result Pattern hair loss, also known as androgenetic alopecia, is a hair loss condition that primarily affects the top and front of the scalp e9c9fb3b36

It usually refers to a male pattern of hair growth in a female that may be a sign of a more serious medical condition, especially if it develops well after puberty e9c9fb3b36

A university-led study (including several authors who are advisors to companies such as Pfizer) in 103 women comparing alfatradiol to minoxidil, another topical hair loss treatment, found the latter to be more effective. In contrast to minoxidil, alfatradiol did not result in an increase of hair density or thickness, but only... e9c9fb3b36 Hirsutism is usually the result of an underlying endocrine imbalance, which may be adrenal, ovarian, or central. It can be caused by increased levels of androgen hormones. The amount and location of the hair is measured by a Ferriman–Gallwey score. It is different from hypertrichosis, which is excessive hair

growth anywhere on the body. Adverse effects from finasteride are rare in men with already enlarged prostates; however, some men experience sexual dysfunction, depression, and breast enlargement. In some men, sexual dysfunction may persist after stopping the medication. It may also hide the early symptoms of certain forms of prostate cancer.

Patients will notice either focal or diffuse loss of hair. This may occur due to thinning...

Alfatradiol It is a stereoisomer of the endogenous steroid hormone and estrogen 17β -estradiol (or simply estradiol). Comparing alfatradiol to minoxidil, another topical hair loss treatment, found the latter to be more effective. In contrast to minoxidil, alfatradiol did not. Alfatradiol, also known as 17α -estradiol and sold under the brand names Avicis, Avixis, Ell-Cranell Alpha, and Pantostin, is a weak estrogen and 5α -reductase inhibitor medication which is used topically in the treatment of pattern hair loss (androgenic alopecia or

pattern baldness) in men and women

This list was last comprehensively updated in July 2025. It is likely to become outdated with time. The cause of female pattern hair loss remains unclear; androgenetic alopecia for women is associated with an increased risk of polyendocrine metabolic ovarian syndrome. Depending on the cause, treatment options include: topical minoxidil, oral finasteride, anti-fungal medications, steroids, hair transplantation, or platelet rich plasma (PRP) therapy. Alternatives for total hair loss include the use of hairpieces or hair fibers. == Medical uses == Latanoprost was approved for medical use in the United States and the European Union in 1996. It is on the World Health Organization's List of Essential Medicines. Latanoprost is available as a generic medication. In 2023, it was the 67th most commonly prescribed medication in the United States, with more than 9 million prescriptions. It is

available as a fixed-dose combination with netarsudil as netarsudil/latanoprost and with timolol as latanoprost/timolol. e9c9fb3b36 Side effects of oral minoxidil may include low blood pressure, water retention and edema, salt retention, rapid heartbeat, dizziness, lightheadedness, headaches, excessive hair growth, and temporary hair shedding. Adverse effects of topical minoxidil include skin irritation, itching, dandruff, and temporary hair shedding.
