G factor (psychometrics) The g factor typically accounts for 40 to 50 percent of the between-individual performance differences on a given cognitive test, and composite scores ("IQ scores") based on many tests are frequently regarded as estimates of individuals' standing on the g factor. However, the g factor itself is a statistical construct driven by the level of observed correlation between cognitive tasks. The terms IQ, general intelligence, general cognitive ability, general mental ability, and simply intelligence are often used interchangeably to refer to this common core shared by cognitive tests. The measured value of this construct depends on the cognitive tasks that are used, and little is known about the underlying causes of the observed correlations. == Establishment == The ground is located in the central area of Tunbridge Wells Common, close to the Wellington Rocks, an outcrop of Ardingly Sandstone laid down in the Lower Cretaceous period. It is on Fir Tree Road, around 250 metres (0.16 mi) from the A264 road to the north and 500 metres (0.31 mi) from the A26 road to the south and east. The centre of Tunbridge Wells is 600 metres (0.37 mi) east of the ground. Common factors influence more than one manifest variable and "factor loadings" are measures of the influence of a common factor on a manifest In multivariate statistics, exploratory factor analysis (EFA) is a statistical method used to uncover the underlying structure of a relatively large set of variables. Measured variables are any one of several attributes of people that may be observed and measured. It is commonly used by researchers when developing a scale (a scale is a collection of questions used to measure a particular research topic) and serves to identify a set of latent constructs underlying a battery of measured variables. Usually, researchers would have a large number of measured variables, which are assumed to be related to a smaller number of "unobserved" factors.

Examples of measured variables could be the physical height, weight, and pulse rate of a human being. Researchers must carefully consider the number of measured variables to include in the analysis. EFA is a technique within factor analysis whose overarching goal is to identify the underlying relationships between measured variables e7d6cb523d

A multiple of a number is the product of that number and an integer. For example, 10 is a multiple of 5 because $5 \times 2 = 10$, so 10 is divisible by 5 and 2.
