The term applied behavior analysis has replaced behavior modification because the latter approach suggested changing behavior without clarifying the relevant behavior-environment interactions. In contrast, ABA changes behavior by first assessing the functional relationship between a targeted behavior and the environment, a process known as a functional behavior assessment. Qualitative research is often used to explore complex phenomena or to gain insight into people's experiences and perspectives on a particular topic. Qualitative methods include ethnography, grounded theory, discourse analysis, and interpretative phenomenological analysis. It is particularly useful when researchers want to understand the meaning that people attach to their experiences or when they want to uncover the underlying reasons for people's behavior.
