Stirling Prize It is named after the architect James Stirling, organised and awarded annually by the Royal Institute of British Architects (RIBA). The Stirling Prize is presented to "the architects of the building that has made the greatest The Royal Institute of British Architects Stirling Prize is a British prize for excellence in architecture. Until 2014 the building could have been anywhere in the European Union, but since 2015 entries have had to be in the United Kingdom. The Stirling Prize is presented to "the architects of the building that has made the greatest contribution to the evolution of architecture in the past year". The architects must be RIBA members. The award was founded in 1996, and is considered to be the most prestigious architecture award in the United Kingdom. The presentation ceremony has been televised by Channel 4. == History == While Muslims agree that riba is prohibited, not all agree on its precise definition. The term is often used to refer to interest charged on loans, and the widespread belief among Muslims that all loan or bank interest is riba forms the basis of the \$2 trillion Islamic banking industry. However, not all Islamic scholars have equated riba with all forms of interest; nor do they agree on whether riba is a major sin or simply discouraged (makruh), or on whether it is a violation of Sharia law to be punished by humans rather than by God.

Some five years later, the same organisation, plus Historic England, criticised AHMM's "harmful" proposals for another Lasdun-designed London building, Milton Gate. He serves on their London Advisory Committee, High Streets Heritage Action Zone Board. == Rick Mather Architects == Derbyshire is on the governing body of WCCA Worshipful Company of Chartered Architects, a modern livery company of the City of London. WCCA exists to promote architecture in the City of London and the architectural profession globally. Mather set up his own practice, Rick Mather Architects, in 1973. The partners at Rick Mather Architects Gavin Miller and Stuart Cade have since launched a new practice MICA, which will complete the remaining RMA projects, whilst simultaneously working on its own strategic masterplans, buildings and landscapes. Jones served as president of the Royal Society of Ulster Architects from May 2012 to 2014. He was elected as president of the Royal Institute of British Architects (RIBA) for two years from 1 September 2019, the first person from Northern Ireland to hold that office. During his presidency, information relating to him was not adequately protected and controlled by the RIBA, eventually admitted by the RIBA in a June 2025 statement. He served his two-year term as RIBA president, but feeling unable to support a proposal to renew the contract of the RIBA chief
