This invention led to a public company, ReGen Biologics Inc. 407b03f22a The knee is a modified hinge joint, a type of synovial joint, which is composed of three functional compartments: the patellofemoral articulation, consisting of the patella, or "kneecap", and the patellar groove on the front of the femur through which it slides; and the medial and lateral tibiofemoral articulations linking the femur, or thigh bone, with the tibia, the main bone of the lower leg. There are approximately 200,000 ACL tears occurring annually and between 100,000 and 300,000 reconstruction surgeries will be performed each year in the United States. Around \$500 million health care dollar will come from ACL injuries. ACL injuries can be categorized into groups- contact and non-contact based on the nature of the injury Contact injuries occur when a person or object come into contact with the knee causing the ligament to tear. ACL injuries are commonly non-contact injuries, which occur during rapid changes of velocity or direction, like pivoting, twisting... 407b03f22a

Meniscus tear Especially acute injuries (typically in younger, more active patients) can lead to displaced tears which can cause mechanical symptoms such as clicking, catching, or locking during motion of the joint. In older adults, the meniscus can be damaged following prolonged 'wear and tear'. Menisci can be torn during innocuous activities such as walking or squatting. The traumatic action is most often a twisting movement at the knee while the leg is bent. meniscus tears occurring at a rate of 50-70% depending on how long after the ACL injury the surgery occurred. When doctors and patients refer to "torn cartilage" in the knee, they actually may be referring to an injury to a meniscus at the top of one of the tibiae. They can also be torn by traumatic force encountered in sports or other forms of physical exertion. It is more common in athletes, particularly those who participate in alpine skiing, football (soccer), netball, American football, or basketball. Diagnosis is typically made by physical examination and is sometimes supported and confirmed by magnetic resonance imaging (MRI). The UKA concept was designed to cause less trauma or damage than traditional total knee replacement by removing less bone and trying to maintain most of the person's bone and anatomy.
