The first attempts to computerize the architectural design date back to the 1960s: add57cfa90 The term information architecture was coined by Richard Saul Wurman. Since its inception, information architecture has become an emerging community of practice focused on applying principles of design, architecture and information science in digital spaces. add57cfa90 As of August 2025, the Society has 69,691 members, of which 13,447 are student members. Typically, a model or concept of information is used and applied to activities which require explicit details of complex information systems. These activities include library systems and database development. add57cfa90 The original aim of CIMOSA (1992) was "to elaborate an open system architecture for CIM and to define a set of concepts and rules to facilitate the building of future CIM systems". One of the main ideas of CIMOSA is the categorization of manufacturing operations in: add57cfa90 The project began with two aims: to prove the practicality of the Williams tube, an early form of computer memory based on standard cathode-ray tubes (CRTs); and to construct a machine that could be used to investigate how computers might be able to assist in the solution of mathematical problems. The first of the series, the Manchester Baby, ran its first program on 21 June 1948. As the world's first stored-program computer, the Baby, and the Manchester Mark 1 developed from it, quickly attracted the attention of the United Kingdom government, who contracted the electrical engineering firm of Ferranti to produce a commercial version. The resulting machine, the Ferranti Mark 1, was the world's first commercially available general-purpose computer. add57cfa90 == Overview == add57cfa90 Each SPA is autonomous and exercises independent control over its day-to-day operations.
