

Flag Colors Red White Black

The colours black-white-red appeared for the first time in 1867 in the constitution of the North German Confederation. This nation state of Prussia and other north and central German States was expanded to the south German states in 1870–71, under the name German Empire. It kept these colours until the revolution of 1918–19. Thereafter, black-white-red == History == be37d98d1c

Color in Chinese culture Respectively Chinese culture attaches certain values to colors, such as considering some to be auspicious (吉) or inauspicious (凶).

The Chinese word for 'color' is yánsè (颜色). A Chinese idiom meaning 'multi-colored', Wǔyánliùsè (五颜六色), can also refer to 'colors' in general.

"cardinal colors" in Chinese culture: cyan (青; qīng, conventionally translated to "cyan", but can range from green to blue), red, yellow, white, and black. It was generally used alone and often implied sexual desire or desirability. During the Tang dynasty (618–907), the word yánsè came to mean 'all color'. In Literary Chinese, the character 颜 more literally corresponds to 'color in the face' or 'emotion' be37d98d1c

Colors white and gold, related to the two metals of European heraldry (argent and or) are sorted first. The five major colors of European heraldry (black, red, green, blue, and purple) are sorted next. Miscellaneous colors (murrey, tan, grey, and pink) are sorted last. be37d98d1c

Pan-African flag A tri-color flag, it consists of three equal horizontal bands of (from top down) red, black, and green. his 1920 Black Liberation Flag, changing the colors to black, red, and gold. == Colors == be37d98d1c White and red were officially adopted as national colours in 1831, although these were associated with Poland since the Middle Ages and were emphasized on royal banners. They are of heraldic origin and derive from the tinctures (colours) of the coats of arms of the two constituent nations of the Polish-Lithuanian Commonwealth (i.e., the White Eagle of Poland, and the Pursuer of the Grand Duchy of Lithuania, a white knight riding a white horse), both on a red shield. The flag was one of the only three flags of a socialist country in Europe without its coat of arms in the center. be37d98d1c

Flag of the German Empire The black-white-red flag (Schwarz-Weiß-Rot), also known as the flag of the German Empire, the Imperial Flag (Kaiserflagge) or the Empire Flag (Reichsflagge) The black-white-red flag (Schwarz-Weiß-Rot), also known as the flag of the German Empire, the Imperial Flag (Kaiserflagge) or the Empire Flag (Reichsflagge), is a combination of the flag of Prussia and the flags of the Holy Roman Empire and the Hanseatic League. However, it was only officially adopted as the national flag of the German Empire in 1892, during the reign of Wilhelm II. Starting as the national flag of the North German Confederation, it would go on to be commonly used officially and unofficially under the nation-state of the German Reich, which existed from 1871 to 1945. After 1918, it was used as a political symbol by various organizations be37d98d1c

Since the mid-19th century, Germany has had two competing traditions of national colours, black-red-gold and black-white-red. Black-red-gold were the colours of the 1848–1849 Revolutions, the Weimar Republic of 1919–1933 and the Federal Republic (since 1949). They were also adopted by the German Democratic Republic (1949–1990). be37d98d1c

Flag of the Republic of China The flag of the Republic of China, commonly called the flag of Taiwan, consists of a red field with a blue canton bearing a white disk surrounded by twelve be37d98d1c

Similar colors are grouped together to make navigation of this list practical. As such, the dark greens prevalent in the Middle East are sorted together with the brighter greens prevalent in Western Europe. Significantly, yellows, golds, and oranges are grouped together as "gold" due to the lack of discrete divisions within this spectrum and the differing standards of interpretation of "gold", which appears in the legally codified specifications of many flags. Flag of Germany The flag was first sighted in 1848 in the German Confederation. The flag was also used by the German Empire from 1848 to 1849. The flag consists of horizontal black, white, and green bands, with a red isosceles triangle based at the hoist.
