Frailty can have various symptoms including muscle weakness (reduced grip strength), slower walking speed, exhaustion, unintentional weight loss, and frequent falls. Older people with certain medical conditions such as diabetes, heart disease and dementia, are also more likely to have frailty. In addition, adults living with frailty face more symptoms of anxiety and depression than those who do not. b32eb3d4f3 Drugs most often associated with this term include alcohol, amphetamines, barbiturates, benzodiazepines, cannabis,

cocaine, hallucinogens, methaqualone, and opioids. The exact cause of substance abuse is sometimes unclear, but there are two predominant theories: either a genetic predisposition or a habit learned or passed down from others, which, if addiction develops, manifests itself as a possible chronic debilitating disease. ICD-11 Severity is determined by the level of distress experienced and degree of impairment in day-to-day The ICD-11 is the eleventh revision of the International Classification of Diseases (ICD). The ICD is developed and annually updated by the World Health Organization (WHO). It replaces the ICD-10 as the global standard for recording health information and causes of death. Development of the ICD-11 started in 2007 and spanned over a decade of work, involving over 300 specialists from 55 countries divided into 30 work groups, with an additional 10,000 proposals from people all over the world. Following an alpha version in May 2011 and a beta draft in May 2012, a stable version of the ICD-11 was released on 18 June 2018, and officially endorsed by all WHO members during the 72nd World Health Assembly on 28 May 2019. coded as mild, moderate, severe, or severity unspecified b32eb3d4f3

disorders vary with regard to the average age of onset. It is not uncommon for those who have SUD to also have other mental health disorders. The coexistence of both a mental health disorder and a substance use disorder (SUD) is referred to as co-occurring disorders. Substance use disorders are characterized by an array of mental, emotional, physical, and behavioral problems such as chronic guilt; an inability to reduce or stop consuming the substance(s) despite repeated attempts; operating vehicles while intoxicated; and physiological withdrawal symptoms.
