However, technically, Kansai dialect is not a single dialect but a group of related dialects in the region. Each major city and prefecture has a particular dialect, and residents take some pride in their particular dialectal variations. c4f80a2296

Yamato Kingship for the general public that multiple dynasties could have existed in the Kinki region at the time of the Iwai Rebellion, and that before the Emperor Keitai The Yamato Kingship (大和政権, Yamato Ōken) was a tribal alliance centered on the Yamato region (Nara Prefecture) from the 4th century to the 7th century, and ruled over the alliance of noble families in the central and western parts of the Japanese archipelago. After the Taika Reform, the ōkimi as an emperor, at that time, was in

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power, and the Yamato period ended. The age lasted from the 3rd to the 7th century, later than the Yamatai Kingdom. Regarding its establishment, due to the relationship between Yamatai and Yamato's succession to the king's power, there are widely divergent views. The time period is archaeologically known as the Kofun period c4f80a2296
