It is also known as Cup'ik cuisine for the Chevak Cup'ik-dialect-speaking Eskimos of Chevak and Cup'ig cuisine for the Nunivak Cup'ig-dialect-speaking Eskimos of Nunivak Island. Subsistence foods are generally considered by many to be nutritionally superior superfoods. Both food and fish are called neqa in Yup'ik. How to Cheat at Cooking cranberries, and additional sales of 54 million eggs have been credited to the chef after she demonstrated how to boil them on a television show.
