Hip replacement The average cost of a total hip replacement in 2012 was \$40,364 in the United States (about €37,300), and in the range of €7,117 to €11,091 in most European countries. Hip replacement is one of the most common orthopaedic operations. A total hip replacement (total hip arthroplasty) consists of replacing both the acetabulum and the femoral head while hemiarthroplasty generally only replaces the femoral head. Patient satisfaction varies widely between different techniques and implants. Approximately 58% of total hip replacements are estimated to last 25 years. CPM is used following various types of reconstructive joint surgery such as knee replacement and ACL reconstruction. Its mechanisms of action for aiding joint recovery are dependent upon what surgery is performed. One mechanism is the movement of synovial fluid to allow for better diffusion of nutrients into damaged cartilage, and diffusion of other materials out; such as blood and metabolic waste products. Another mechanism is the prevention of fibrous scar tissue formation in the joint, which tends to decrease the range of motion for a joint. The concept was created by Robert B. Continuous passive motion The goals of phase 1 rehabilitation are: control post-operative pain, reduce inflammation, provide passive motion in a specific plane of movement, and protect the healing repair or tissue. "Rehabilitation protocols following total knee arthroplasty: a review of study designs and outcome measures"; Continuous passive motion (CPM) devices are used during the first phase of rehabilitation following a soft tissue surgical procedure or trauma. CPM is carried out by a CPM device, which constantly moves the joint through a controlled range of motion; the exact range is dependent upon the joint, but in most cases the range of motion is increased over time. **Manipulation under anesthesia** Range of motion data - Manipulation under anesthesia (MUA) or fibrosis release procedures is a noninvasive procedure to treat chronic pain which has been unmanageable by other methods. MUA can be performed by many different types of medical professionals, although they must have studied MUA and received certification in the technique. MUA is designed not only to relieve pain, but also to break up excessive adhesions (scar tissue) that builds up after orthopedic surgery. These tests are necessary to identify the targeted area and to ensure the patient will benefit from the procedure. The patient normally goes through a series of examinations, including imaging tests and laboratory work, prior to MUA. joint include those with stiff post-operative knee joints that have undergone total knee replacement (total knee arthroplasty TKA). Because scar tissue can impede the movement of soft tissue and joints, MUA is valuable in re-establishing optimal range of motion.

**Knee cartilage replacement therapy** Osteoarthritis and Articular cartilage, most notably that which is found in the knee joint, is generally characterized by very low friction, high wear resistance, and poor regenerative qualities. Osteoarthritis is a common condition of cartilage failure that can lead to limited range of motion, bone damage and invariably, pain. Due to a combination of acute stress and chronic fatigue, osteoarthritis directly manifests itself in a wearing away of the articular surface and, in extreme cases, bone can be exposed in the joint. Some additional examples of cartilage failure mechanisms include cellular matrix linkage rupture, chondrocyte protein synthesis inhibition, and chondrocyte apoptosis. 2017).

It is responsible for much of the compressive resistance and load bearing qualities of the knee joint and, without it, walking is painful to impossible.
