Postterm pregnancy After the 42nd week of gestation, the placenta, which supplies the baby with nutrients and oxygen from the mother, starts aging and will eventually fail. Postmature births carry risks for both the mother and the baby, including fetal malnutrition, meconium aspiration syndrome, and stillbirths. Therefore, a score of 0 points for amniotic fluid may indicate the fetus is at risk. Fetal movement Muscles begin to move as soon as they are innervated. These first movements are not reflexive, but arise from self-generated nerve impulses originating in the spinal cord. As the nervous system matures, muscles can move in response to stimuli. 14 weeks. By about week 21, the fetus begins to develop a regular schedule of movement. Locomotor activity begins during the late embryological stage and changes in nature throughout development. Excessive amniotic fluid indicates that the fetus's urine output is larger than expected, indicating a larger baby Large for gestational age (LGA) is a term used to describe infants that are born with an abnormally high weight, specifically in the 90th percentile or above, compared to other babies of the same developmental age. the newborn is likely large in volume. Typically the threshold for diagnosing macrosomia is a body weight between 4,000 and 4,500 grams (8 lb 13 oz and 9 lb 15 oz), or more, measured at birth, but there are difficulties reaching a universal agreement of this definition e415742941

Generally speaking, fetal motility can be classified as either elicited or spontaneous, and spontaneous movements may be triggered by either the spine or the brain. The earliest responses to sound have been observed at around 16 weeks of gestation, while the auditory system is considered fully functional between 25 and 29 weeks of gestation. Rho(D) immune globulin It is made from human blood plasma. It is often given both during and following pregnancy. The RhD status of the fetus is determined by genetic inheritance. It is given by injection into muscle or a vein. condition is called erythroblastosis fetalis and can be fatal to the fetus. RhIG is commonly referred to as 'anti-D'. A single dose lasts 12 weeks. It may also be used when RhD-negative people are given RhD-positive blood. In a pregnancy Rho(D) immune globulin (RhIG) is a medication used to prevent RhD isoimmunization in mothers who are RhD negative and to treat idiopathic thrombocytopenic purpura (ITP) in people who are Rh positive e415742941
