According... Blood is composed of blood cells suspended in plasma. Plasma, which constitutes 55% of blood fluid, is mostly water (92% by volume), and contains proteins, glucose, mineral ions, and hormones. The blood cells are mainly red blood cells (erythrocytes), white blood cells (leukocytes), and (in mammals) platelets (thrombocytes). The most abundant cells are red blood cells. These contain hemoglobin, which facilitates oxygen transport by reversibly binding to it, increasing its solubility. Jawed vertebrates have an adaptive immune system, based largely on white blood cells. White blood cells help to resist infections and parasites. Platelets are important in the clotting of blood.

The best-known is the common pheasant, which is widespread throughout the world, in introduced feral populations and in farm operations. Blood in stool The term can refer either to melena, with a black appearance, typically originating from upper gastrointestinal bleeding; or to hematochezia, with a red color, typically originating from lower gastrointestinal bleeding. Evaluation of the blood found in stool depends on its characteristics, in terms of color, quantity and other features, which can point to its source, but more serious conditions can present with a mixed picture, or with the form of bleeding that is found in another section of the tract. The term "blood in stool" is usually only used to describe visible blood, and not fecal occult blood, which is found only after physical examination and chemical laboratory testing. The generic name *Lythrum* is derived from the Greek 'lythron', meaning blood, in reference to the flower colour in some species. The specific epithet *salicaria* probably derives from the similarity of the leaves to those of willows or *Salix* species, though Linnaeus did not specify this in his choice of the name. Purple-loosestrife was referred to several times as 'long purples' by John Clare, such as in his 1821 poem *The Wildflower Nosegay*:

Red-eared firetail Males and females are similar in colouring and bond as lifelong pairs that occupy a territory centred on their roosting and brooding nest site. Most observations occur when their soft voice is heard, or in flight when flushed from the dense scrub. Red-eared firetails are usually only glimpsed briefly, if at all, as they move rapidly and discreetly through their habitat.
