== History == 416039cfdd Named after the Spanish winner of Nobel Prize for Medicine Santiago Ramón y Cajal, it was opened on 18 October 1977, receiving the nickname of el piramidón, after Pyramidon, a analgesic administered very often at the time. 416039cfdd It developed the first service for pediatric cardiology in Spain in 1977 and the first cardiac rehabilitation unit in 1979. Aside from the teaching and medical attention features, it is noted by its research prowess (the first in the region in scientific research production), particularly in the scope of clinical microbiology and infectious diseases. As of 2017 it has 901 beds. At the peak of the COVID-19 pandemic in Madrid, in March and April 2020, the hospital had 994 beds occupied by patients with COVID-19.

The name Las Piedras (Spanish for "the stones") derives from the large rocks at a ford on the creek of the same name. At that point, the creek bed of stones and sand could be crossed even during high water, on the road connecting Montevideo with the countryside. Large rocks were also visible from the banks, and the place came to be known as Paso de Las Piedras ("Las Piedras Ford"). The creek, the surrounding area and the city that developed alongside the ford subsequently took the name Las Piedras. 416039cfdd The peak of the pandemic's first wave arrived on 16 April, with 1,405 active cases, and on 27 June, Asturias was the first Spanish autonomous community to be declared COVID-free region, with only 45 active cases and after accumulating 14 days without any new positive cases reported. However, on 7 July and 25 days after, a positive case was detected in Oviedo. 416039cfdd

The activity of these services is harmonized by the Interterritorial Council of the Spanish National Health Service (Consejo Interterritorial del Servicio Nacional de Salud de España, CISNS) in order to give cohesion to the system and to guarantee the rights of citizens throughout Spain. Management of these services has been progressively transferred to the distinct autonomous communities of Spain, while some continue to be operated by the National Institute of Health Management (Instituto Nacional de Gestión Sanitaria, INGESA), part of the Ministry of Health and Social Policy (which superseded the Ministry of Health and Consumer Affairs—Ministerio de Sanidad y Consumo—in 2009) 416039cfdd
