Distributed systems cost more than monolithic architectures, primarily due to increased needs for additional hardware, servers, gateways, firewalls, new subnets, proxies, and so on. Distributed systems can also suffer from fallacies of distributed computing. Conversely, a well-designed distributed system is more scalable, more durable, more changeable, and more fine-tuned than a monolithic application deployed on a single machine. H-theorem The value  $f(E, t) dE$  is the number of molecules that have kinetic energy between  $E$  and  $E + dE$ .  $H$  itself is defined as  $H(t) = \int_0^\infty f(E, t) \ln f(E, t) dE$ . In classical statistical mechanics, the H-theorem, introduced by Ludwig Boltzmann in 1872, describes the tendency of the quantity  $H$  (defined below) to decrease in a nearly-ideal gas of molecules. As this quantity  $H$  was meant to represent the entropy of thermodynamics, the H-theorem was an early demonstration of the power of statistical mechanics as it claimed to derive the second law of thermodynamics—a statement about fundamentally irreversible processes—from reversible microscopic mechanics. It is thought to prove the second law of thermodynamics, albeit under the assumption of low-entropy initial conditions. time  $t$  828c862219
