Word-sense disambiguation is a process used by people and computers to determine the intended meaning of a word. It relies on context, such as adjacent words, phrases, purpose, the known or probable purpose, and register of the conversation, or document, and orientation, to narrow down the possible senses to the most likely one. Polysemy refers to the property of a word or phrase having multiple semes or sememes, resulting in multiple senses. 9ed5c4ee57 At the foundation of example-based machine translation is the idea of translation by analogy. When applied to the process of human translation, the idea that translation takes place by analogy is a rejection of the idea that people translate sentences by doing deep linguistic analysis. Instead, it is founded on the belief that people translate by first decomposing a sentence into certain phrases, then by translating these phrases, and finally by properly composing these fragments into one long sentence. Phrasal translations are translated by analogy to previous translations. The principle of translation by analogy is encoded to example-based machine translation through the example translations that are used to train such a system. 9ed5c4ee57

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The concept of "word" is distinguished from that of a morpheme, which is the smallest unit of language that has a meaning, even if it cannot stand on its own. Words are made out of at least one morpheme. Morphemes can also be joined to create other words in a process of morphological derivation. == Description == 9ed5c4ee57 Measure words denote a unit of measurement and are used with mass nouns (uncountable nouns), and in some cases also with count nouns. For instance, in English, mud is a mass noun and thus one cannot say "three muds", but one can say "three drops of mud", "three pails of mud", etc. In these examples, drops and pails function as measure words.
