"What Lines per inch (LPI) is a measurement of printing resolution. The quality of printer device or screen determines how high the LPI will be. Specifically LPI is a measure of how close together the lines in a halftone grid are. A line consists of halftones that is built up by physical ink dots made by the printer device to create different tones. e. High LPI indicates greater detail and sharpness. Standards for the exact length of an inch have varied in the past, but since the adoption of the international yard during the 1950s and 1960s the inch has been based on the metric system and defined as exactly 25.4 mm. It used the standard German naval system of ammunition where the base charge was held in a metallic cartridge case and supplemented by another charge in a silk bag. Both cartridges were rammed together.

They entered service in 1914 aboard Texas and her sister ship New York shortly after. At the time of their introduction they were intended to fire 1,400 lb (640 kg) armor-piercing (AP) projectiles containing a bursting charge of explosive D. Propellant charge was four silk bags of smokeless powder, each of which weighed 105 lb (48 kg). At a 15-degree angle, the guns could fire a shell out to 23,000 yd (21,000 m).
