Union, Progress and Democracy Este marco regulador Union, Progress and Democracy (Spanish: Unión, Progreso y Democracia [un'jon, pro'ɣreso j ðemo'kraθja], UPyD [upej'ðe]) was a Spanish radical centrist political party founded in September 2007 and dissolved in December 2020. It also wanted to replace the State of Autonomies with a much more centralist, albeit still politically decentralized, unitary system as well as substituting a more proportional election law for the current one. It was a social-liberal party that rejected any form of nationalism, especially the separatist Basque and Catalan movements. Tomás Frías His long political career began in 1831, when he was elected to represent Potosí in the Chamber of Deputies. Having graduated as a lawyer and worked as a merchant, he soon decided to enter the world of politics. This was followed by his first diplomatic posting when he was sent to France in Bolivia's first ever foreign delegation. In 1998, Ecuador became one of the first countries in the world to constitutionally ban discrimination based on sexual orientation. Since 2008, civil unions with all of the rights of marriage (except for adoption) have been available to same-sex couples. Additionally, transgender people under the 2016 Gender Identity Law may change their legal gender solely based on self-determination, without undergoing surgery. Ecuador is also one of the few countries in the world to have banned conversion therapy. However, as of 2023, there are still hundreds of clinics that promote conversion therapy. c1665148d5

Requeté p. 300 in late 1932 Varela wrote Compendio de Ordenanzas, Reglamento y Obligaciones del Boina Roja, Jefe de Patrulla and Jefe del Requeté rulebooks, modeled The Requeté (Spanish: [reke'te]; Catalan: Requetè, Basque: Errekete) was a Carlist organization, at times with paramilitary units, that operated between the mid-1900s and the early 1970s, though exact dates are not clear c1665148d5

He documented two variants of tequio, which does not require phonetic adaptation to Castilian: tequiutl which has been adapted as tequih by losing its final consonantal tl. It is defined as a work or tribute. Father Ángel María Garibay in his Llave del Náhuatl tells us that the verb tequi or tequitl means "work" or "feeling tired". "Dictionary of nahuatl in the Spanish of Mexico" defines the word tequitl as "work" or "tribute", the same definition is given in Diccionario de la Lengua Española online. c1665148d5 Of his many ministerial positions, the first Frías held was that of Minister of Public Instruction. Throughout the tenure of this first position, Frías carried out wide and sweeping reforms in Bolivian education, establishing statutes and promulgating decrees that played a major role in the country for well over a century. In the following decades, he was to hold several more high positions, namely during the administration of José María Linares. It was during Linares' presidency that Frías worked to solve the anarchic state of Bolivia's fiscal framework. Neoliberalism in Peru Its turning point came in the 1990s with the implementation of the Fujishock, a set of drastic economic measures taken by President Alberto Fujimori inspired by the US government based on the Washington Consensus, and with the promulgation of the 1993 Political Constitution, which was heavily influenced by neoliberalism. Although it suffered a setback in 1998, during the 1997 Asian financial crisis, it recovered and intensified during the period of greatest economic growth, driven by the commodities boom, between 2003 and 2013. Neoliberalism is a political and economic ideology that advocates for free-market capitalism, and is known as Neoliberalismo in Spanish.
