Metal casting Vacuum filling, also known as counter-gravity In metalworking and jewelry making, casting is a process in which a liquid metal is delivered into a mold (usually by a crucible) that contains a negative impression (i. e. , a three-dimensional negative image) of the intended shape. The metal and mold are then cooled, and the metal part (the casting) is extracted. There are a few common methods for filling the mold cavity: gravity, low-pressure, high-pressure, and vacuum. Casting is most often used for making complex shapes that would be difficult or uneconomical to make by other methods. The metal is poured into the mold through a hollow channel called a sprue. in sand 5081ef9b83

There are two broad categories of fillings: direct restorations, placed and shaped directly inside a cleaned cavity in a single dental visit, and indirect restorations (such as inlays or onlays), which are fabricated outside the mouth (often in a laboratory) and then cemented into the tooth. Fillings may also be used to replace or seal tooth structure around dental implants or after more extensive procedures such as root-canal therapy 5081ef9b83
