

What Is Blepharoplasty Eyelid Surgery

Cataract surgery is covered with a cloth or sheet with an opening for the operative eye. The eyelid is held open with a speculum to minimize blinking during surgery. The eye's natural lens is usually replaced with an artificial intraocular lens (IOL) implant. Cataract surgery is the removal of the natural lens of the eye that has developed a cataract, an opaque or cloudy area

MEETH is recognized in medical circles for its long history of contributions in developing the fields of ophthalmology, otolaryngology and plastic surgery. Manhattan Eye, Ear and Throat Hospital was granted a charter from the New York Legislature to found a voluntary, non-profit Eye and Ear hospital on May 9, 1869. They are caught in the vexed immigrants' dilemma of struggling not only to keep up with the Joneses but to look like them, too." == Etymology == An oculoplastic surgeon is a specialized ophthalmologist (MD eye surgeon) who has completed one or two years of additional fellowship training following an ophthalmology residency. Many are fellows of the American Society of Ophthalmic Plastic and Reconstructive Surgeons (ASOPRS). To qualify, a member must have passed both the American Board of Ophthalmology certification exams, as well as written and oral board examinations through ASOPRS. A candidate must also have made a significant contribution to the field of oculoplastics, which may take the form of a peer-reviewed publication. There are other surgeons qualified and certified to operate on the orbit and ocular adnexa such as plastic surgeons, Neurosurgeons and oral and maxillofacial surgeons. The word plastic in plastic surgery refers to the concept of "reshaping" and comes from the Greek πλαστική (τέχνη), *plastikē (tekhnē)*, "the art of modelling" of malleable flesh. An IOL (intraocular lens) is usually implanted in its place (PCIOL), or less frequently in the ciliary sulcus, to restore clear vision. Cataract surgery is performed by an ophthalmologist in an out-patient setting at a surgical centre or hospital. Local anaesthesia (injection) or topical anesthesia (drops) are normally used. The procedure is usually quick and causes little or no pain and minor discomfort.
