The overall Vibram FiveFingers concept was invented by Robert Fliri, a design student from Vinschgau who wanted to "figure out a way to move around in nature better". In 2005, Fliri pitched his idea to Vibram, which was unknown to consumers then despite its numerous shoe manufacturer partnerships; after all of the company's partners rejected the idea, Vibram elected to develop it into a product and market it directly under its own name. Vibram FiveFingers were developed and introduced in 2005. The original shoe was introduced in the United States at 25 stores nationwide in early 2006.

Vibram soles were first used on mountaineering boots, replacing leather soles fitted with hobnails or steel cleats which were commonly used up until then. There are health benefits and some risks associated with going barefoot. Shoes, while they offer protection, can limit the flexibility, strength, and mobility of the foot and can lead to higher incidences of flexible flat foot, bunions, hammer toe, and Morton's neuroma. Walking and running barefoot results in a more natural gait, allowing for a more rocking motion of the foot, eliminating the hard heel strike and generating less collision force in the foot and lower leg. 268aa19ec7
